Houston Pavilions office tower gets new name

The 11-story office building in the downtown Houston Pavilions is now known as NRG Tower, after its newest occupant.

NRG Energy Inc. finished its planned move into the building at 1201 Fannin St. two weeks ago. NRG employees and contractors have been relocating from other downtown locations since January, said **David Knox**, NRG spokesman.

Some 1,300 employees now work in 263,000 square feet of the building.

Houston Pavilions LP converted some vacant retail space into office square footage so there would be enough room for NRG. The 10-year NRG lease was [announced in July 2009](#).

Princeton, N.J.-based NRG (NYSE: NRG) and its subsidiaries operate as a wholesale power generation company.
